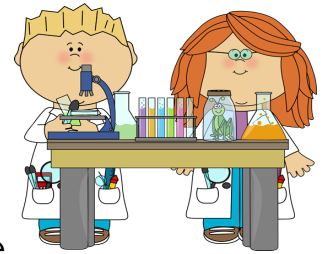


# July Session

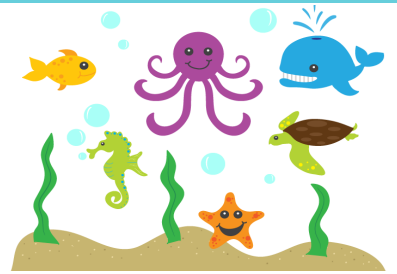


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## **JULY 23rd—AUGUST 3RD** **OUT TO SEA**
