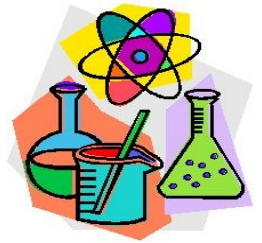


July Session

Sports: Soccer, Badminton, Swimming

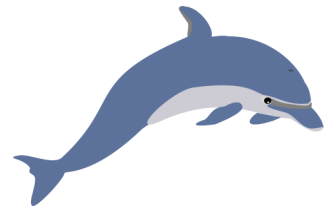
